- For the 2020-21 school year, as measured in the Online Platform Utilization Report, our average daily attendance% for Students Identified as Furthest From Educational Justice will be at or above district average.
- In 2020-2021 80% of students identified as Students Furthest from Educational Justice will earn a C or higher in all courses.
- Our plan for improving the culture and climate for students and families furthest from educational justice include the following: school-wide professional learning on **understanding and dismantling white supremacy culture in education**, school-wide focus on **equitable grading and feedback practices**, and a weekly advisory period focused on **social-emotional learning and community**.
